The Classic Trailer Winter Eventing & Dressage Series is designed to give riders the opportunity to develop their mental and physical competition skills throughout the winter. Horse trials competitors will **not** be permitted to school the show jumping or cross country courses prior to competition. The Classic Trailer Winter & Eventing Dressage Series has been developed in an effort to help horse and rider become stronger competitors and progress in their training. Horse Trials competitors may school the cross country courses and show jumping courses at the completion of the event at no additional charge. Riders who are eliminated will be permitted to complete the competition. Riders who are not competing in the horse trials will be permitted to school cross-country and show jumping at the completion of the event for \$25 per horse/rider combination.

- Dressage: All tests will be in a 20x40m Premier Equestrian Sundance Arena on lime sand footing. Judge: Claudia Coley USDF L
- Show Jumping will be held on grass. May incorporate some terrain changes.
- Cross Country: Shortened cross country tests approximately 8-12 jumps at each level. Terrain questions. Up and down banks, ditch, trakehner, mound, water, turning questions as appropriate for the levels. Cross country questions will change to some degree for each event. There are significant space restrictions for galloping. Be prepared for questions to come up quickly.

Horse Trials

Dressage test, show jumping and cross country. Ribbons awarded 1st-6th at each level. Series Awards presented at each level. **\$60** Horse trials

- 1) Starter Novice Horse Trial: 2015 USDF Intro Test B: Cross country & show jumping fences 2'-2'3". Water (if offered) will be optional. May offer up bank, small step down, small introductory pseudo "ditch". Most fences are narrowapproximately 8' in width.
- 2) Beginner Novice Horse Trial: 2014 USEA BN Test B Nov & Dec. 2018 USEA BN B for February events. Cross county & show jumping fences 2'6" 2'9"
- 3) Novice Horse Trial: 2014 USEA Novice Test B Nov & Dec. 2018 USEA Nov B for February events, Cross country & show jumping fences will not exceed 2'11"
- 4) Novice/Training Horse Trial: 2014 USEA Training Test B. 2018 USEA Training B for February events. Show Jumping fences 3'3". Cross country will offer more technical questions, most with Novice heights. 1-3 straight forward 3'3" XC fences may be offered.

Dressage Tests

Ribbons will NOT be awarded for dressage tests but tests will be placed. Series Awards for USDF Intro, USEF Training and USEF First Level. **\$12 per test**
